The public will have an opportunity to hear from Berkeley County leaders, including Berkeley County Supervisor Bill Peagler, Berkeley County Sheriff Duane Lewis and others. Updates will be presented on public safety, road projects, and other important topics. The public will hear updates on major road projects including Williams Lane, Foster Creek Road at Tanner Ford Boulevard, and other important road improvement projects and topics.
