### **Berkeley County Winter Weather Update #8, January 8, 2018**

MONCKS CORNER, S.C. - (Monday, January 8, 2018)- Berkeley County Government offices resumed normal operations Monday, January 8, 2018.

Berkeley County Emergency Preparedness Department will move back to OPCON 5 at 5 p.m. today.

Berkeley County road conditions have improved significantly; however, many roads remain icy. Officials urge motorists to exercise caution.

So far today, the following roads remain icy and dangerous.

Crews continue to monitor and treat roads around the County and expect road conditions to improve throughout the next two days.

#### **Convenience Centers and Landfill:**

All Berkeley County convenience centers reopened today, operating normal hours, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
