



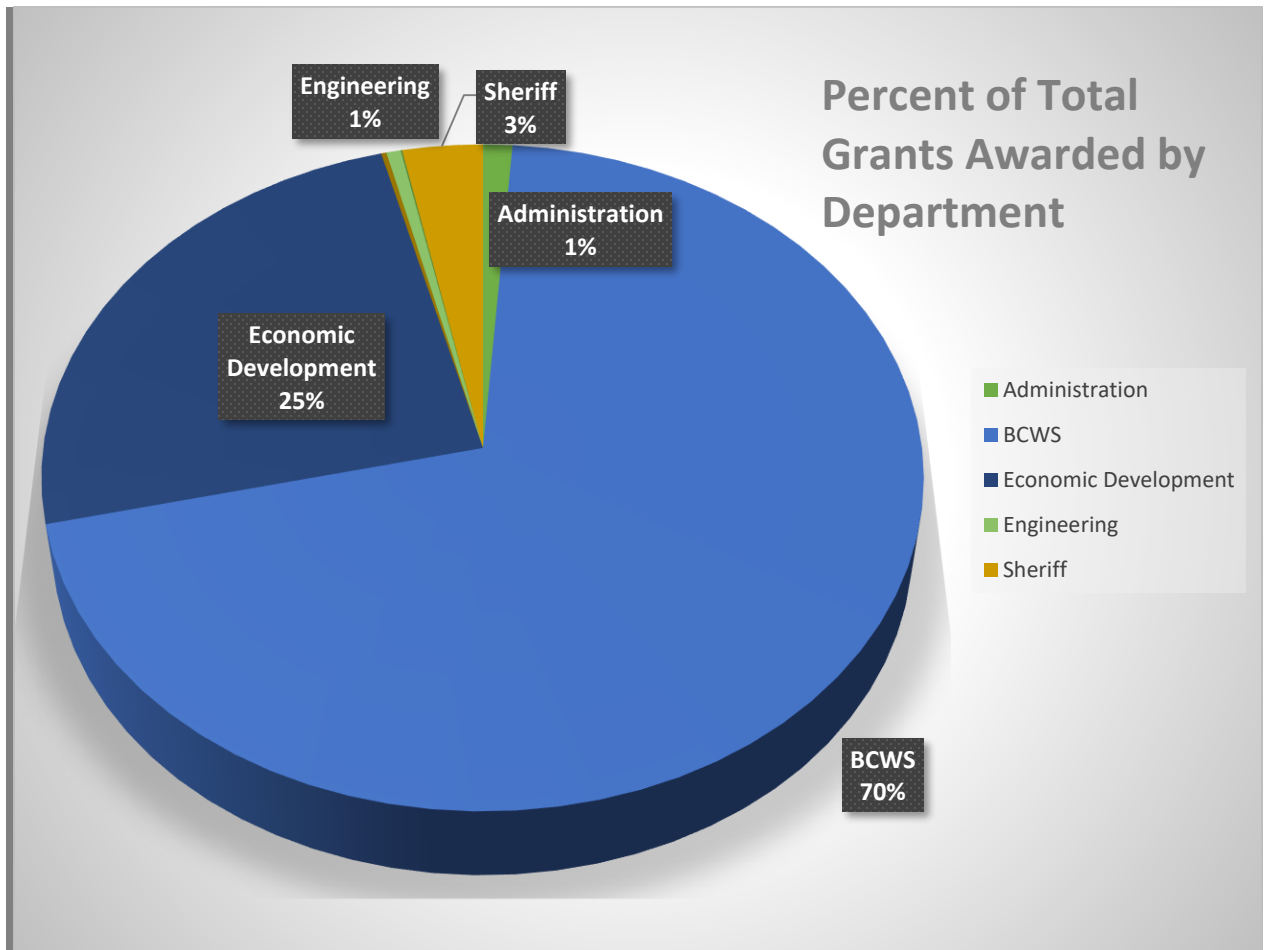

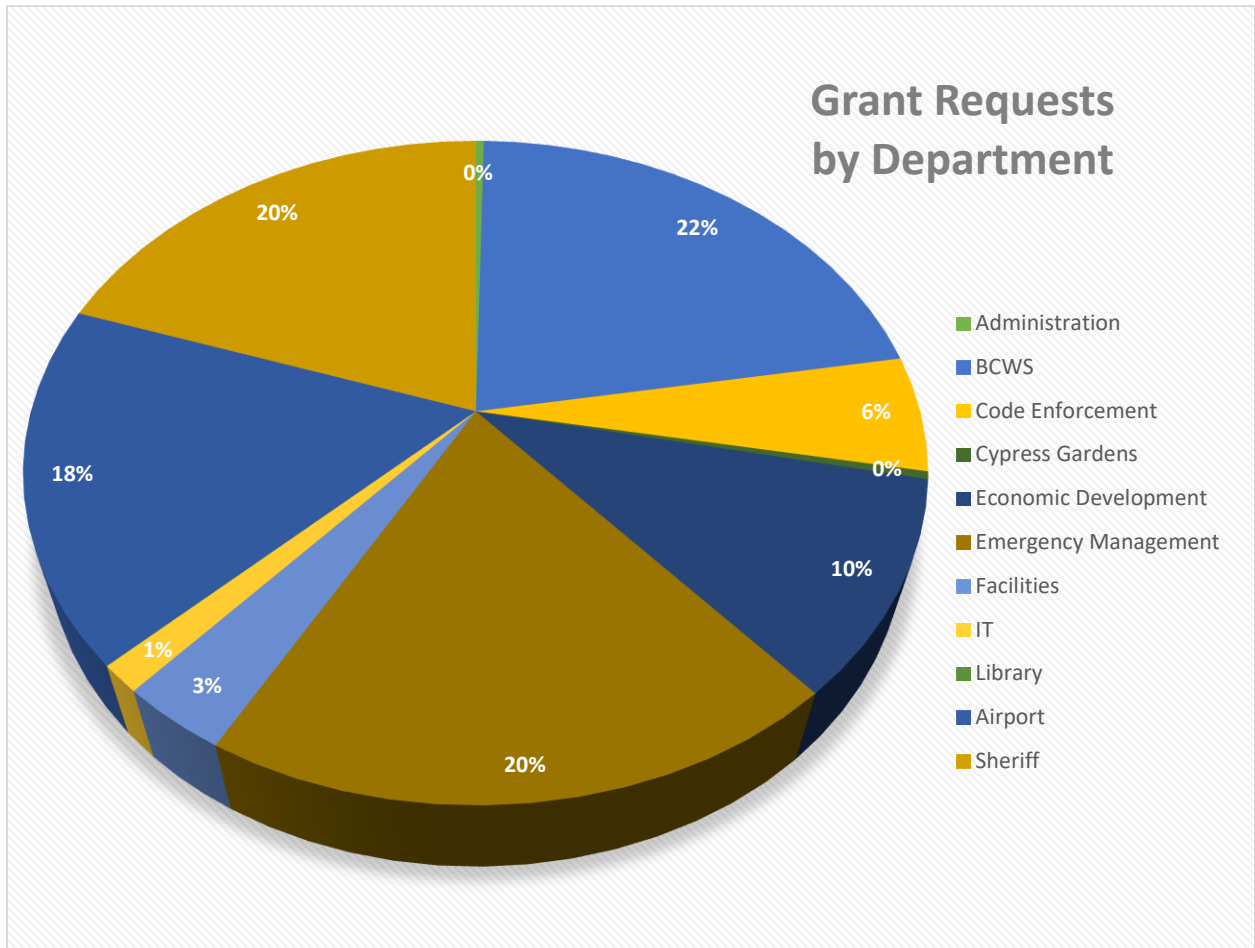

Proposals and Awards, Fiscal Year 2016 Funding Overview

Grants Administration is pleased to present this report on Berkeley County sponsored projects for Fiscal Year 2016, from October 19, 2015 through June 30, 2016. In Fiscal Year 2016, the County received \$4,273,202 in grant awards.



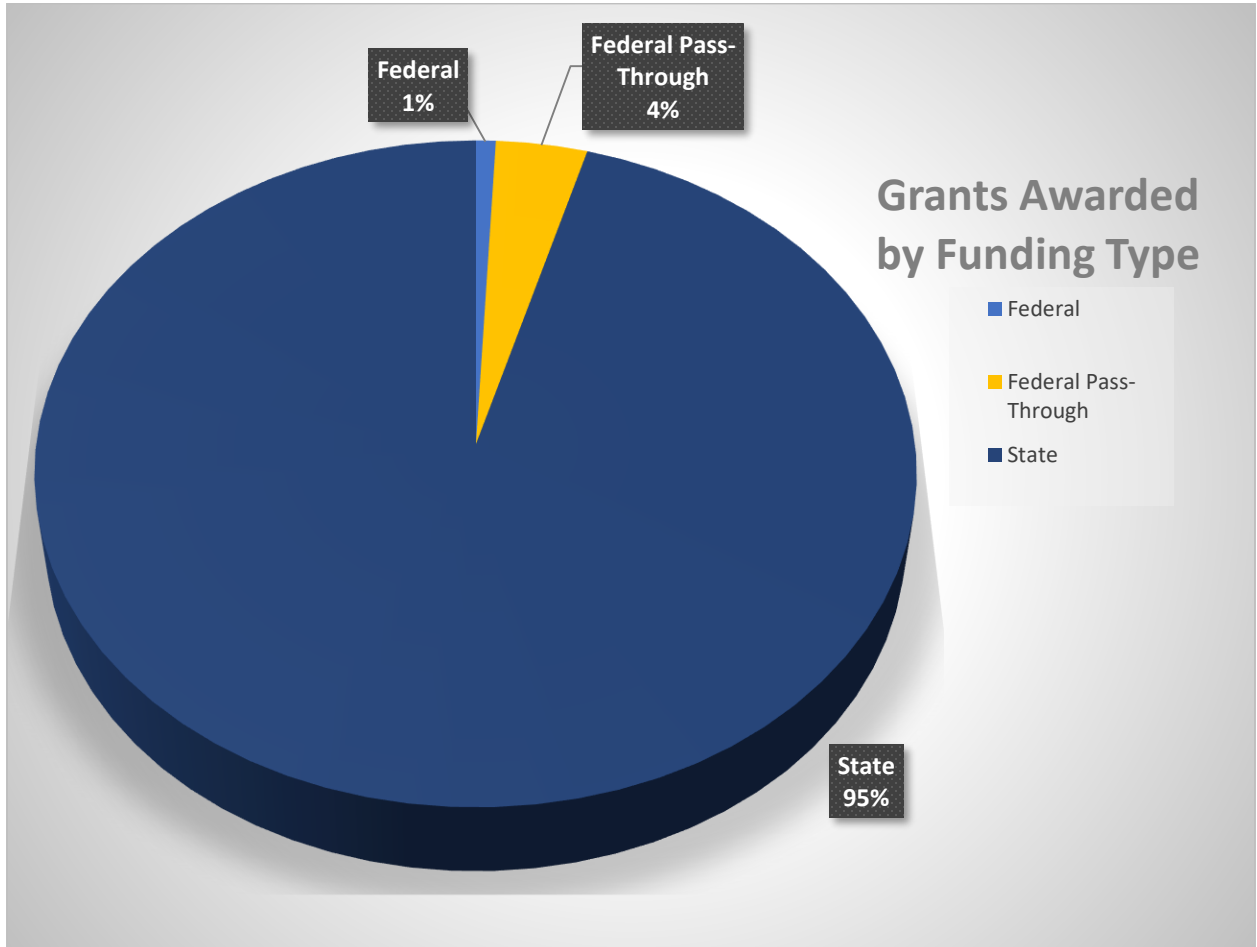
Grants Administration reports 27 proposals during the same time period to Federal State, Corporate and Foundation partners requesting \$14,965,632 in support of various projects.



The following table reflects the total amount requested through Federal, State, Corporate and Foundation funding streams between October 19, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

Federal

Funding from federal sources, either directly or as a pass through totaled \$189,702 in Fiscal Year 2016. The Department of Justice provided the largest share at 72.33% of federal funds received, with \$137,202 in funding. The Department of Housing and Urban Development awarded 26.36% of the federal funding with \$50,000. The Institute of Museum and Library Services granted \$2,500 (1.3%) of Federal funds received.

State

A grant from the South Carolina Rural Infrastructure Authority of \$3,000,000 for the Camp Hall Project made up 73.77% of funds provided by and through the State of South Carolina. The SC Coordinating Council for Economic Development granted Berkeley County \$1,050,000 (25.82%) and the South Carolina Park, Recreation and Tourism Department granted \$16,500, less than half-percent.

Grant awards received between October 19, 2015 and June 30, 2016

During the reporting period, \$33,601 was received directly from the federal government, while \$503,931 was received as a pass-through from a South Carolina State Office. Just over 88% of the funds received [\$4,066,500] came directly through the State of South Carolina.

Funded Projects

Administration - \$50,000

- Support/supplement the administrative costs used by BCDCOG to plan, submit and administer the County's requests to SC Department of Commerce for CDBG funds.

Berkeley County Water and Sanitation - \$3,000,000

- Install elevated water storage tank at Camp Hall development site.

Economic Development - \$1,050,000

- Real property improvements which will create 380 new jobs.

Park and Recreation - \$16,500

- Community park improvements at Alvin, Kittfield, Wassamassaw, Wilder and Pierre Park.

Berkeley County Library System - \$2,500

- TriCounty Literacy Celebration Special Event

Berkeley County Sheriff's Office - \$137,202

- DUI Traffic Deputy, equipment and law enforcement vehicle.
