Berkeley County Sheriff's Office Seeking Public's Help in Finding Armed Robbery Suspect

Suspect Robbed Dollar General This Morning

MONCKS CORNER, SC – Berkeley County Sheriff Duane Lewis is seeking the public's help in identifying an armed robbery suspect from an incident at Dollar General this morning.

Deputies from the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of an armed robbery at the Dollar General Store located at 1326 Red Bank Road in unincorporated Goose Creek shortly around 10:15 AM today.

The suspect walked into the store and picked up a hoodie with a solid-gray top and green and gray horizontal stripes, a blue and black flannel shirt and a blue bandana. The subject then walked up to the register and handed the items to the cashier. After paying the cashier for his purchase, the suspect displayed a firearm and grabbed cash from the drawer. After taking an unknown amount of money from the register, the suspect fled on foot from the store. Fortunately, there were no injuries during the incident.

The suspect is described as:

- Black male with darker complexion and a light goatee
- 5 feet, 10 inches tall
- Wearing a white, short-sleeve t-shirt with the letter "LRG" printed on the front of it, gray sweat pants and dark-colored shoes.
