

Early Voting

On May 13, 2022, Governor McMaster signed into law legislation passed by the General Assembly that establishes Early Voting and makes significant changes to the Absentee Voting process. The information on this page has been updated to reflect these changes.

Early Voting

- In-person absentee voting has now been replaced with a two-week early voting period. Any qualified voter can visit an early-voting location in their county and vote like they would at their polling place on Election Day.
- For statewide general elections, the early voting centers must be open from 8:30 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday on each day of the early voting period.
- For any election that is not a statewide general election or runoff election, the early voting centers must be open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. during the early voting period.
- For any runoff election, the early voting centers must be open on the Wednesday through Friday immediately preceding the election and must be open from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
- For any election, the early voting centers must not be open on Sundays or on legal holidays.
- YOUR VALID PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED TO VOTE.
